Please be aware that we invest time in this website in hopes that you refer to it whenever you have a question on when a certain event is happening, or where.

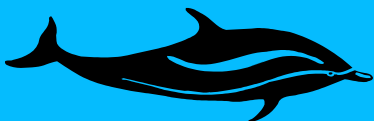
